

2008 Anti Poverty Week Snapshot



30 centres participated

2243 people participate in events. An known number were exposed to the message at the public events such as Mt Gambier

21 centres engaged local health workers

30 centres had a healthy food component to the promotion

118 organisations were involved in the planning of Anti-Poverty Week events

17 centres had media coverage

3 centres had television coverage

6 centres had radio coverage
